## **Fumigation Preparation Checklist**

Inside Your Home:			
	Remove all items that are intended for human consumption that are not in factory-sealed, airtight containers such as sealed glass or metal. These items include foods, beverages, drugs, and medicines, as well as items in refrigerators and freezers.		Remove baby crib mattresses entirely (including bassinets, playards, or pack-n-plays).
			Remove all other plastic coverings on mattresses and pillows must be removed. Any mattress that has a plastic covering must also be removed.
	emove all living plants and all animals, including fish.		Remove any high-density foam mattresses, including
	Extinguish pilot lights.		TemperPedic, PosturePedic, or any other type of foam mattress.
	Make arrangements with your gas supplier to turn your gas off and on.		Please remove all linens from mattresses.
	Electricity and water must be turned on.		Open all cabinet doors, closet doors, and drawers a minimum of four inches.
	Unplug all heating elements, including those on pianos and organs.		If there is a safe large enough for a child to enter, it must be opened and inspected before fumigation and again
	Unplug all TV sets and computer equipment.		before the structure is released back to the customer.
	Turn off air conditioning units.		Raise blinds, open drapes, and open attic access.
Outdoors Areas and Backyard:			
	Move any loose items, including plants, tables, chairs that are closer than 6 feet to the building and move any vines attached to the building, because shrubbery and tree branches may be damaged or burned. Cut back plants, branches, foliage and other growth far enough away from the building to allow the tent to fall freely to the ground.		Remove any fences connected to structure. Our fumigator will consult with you on trellises or other items that may interfere with tenting.
			Rake back mulch and rock 18" from the foundation to ensure a proper seal.
	Tree limbs over the roof must be trimmed back.  Heavily water all shrubs and plants that are located alongside the structure.		Remove any decks that are connected to the structure unless the deck is being covered by the tent.
			Remove pool enclosure screens prior to fumigation.
